The State Rehabilitation Council (SRC) continues to seek members to serve as representatives of Business, Labor and Industry.

- ◆ The SRC serves in an advisory capacity to Iowa Vocational Rehabilitation Services (IVRS).
- ◆ Members are the voice of IVRS consumers and stakeholders as advocates for vocational rehabilitation.
- ◆ In partnership with IVRS, SRC members share the common goal and mission *to provide expert, individualized services to Iowans with disabilities to achieve their independence through successful employment and economic support.*

Members to the State Rehabilitation Council are governor-appointed; a term is three years. The council meets four times per year.

Iowa Code Section 69.16 requires all appointive boards, commissions, committees and councils to be gender-balanced and bipartisan in their composition. To achieve this balance, we have a current need for male representatives of Business, Labor and Industry who are registered with no party affiliation or the Republican Party. However, all interested in joining the SRC are encouraged to apply!
